#### Beer

Oceanside's food scene, known near and far for its particular brand of "flip flop" fine dining, is always evolving. Two-story beachside restaurant <u>The Surf</u> <u>Club</u> is now under new ownership by Oceanside locals Kevin and Alvin Mansour who are planning a full renovation in 2025. The Surf Club serves quintessential beach eats including tacos, salads, bowls, and more, along with live music Fridays through Sundays on the rooftop and ground floor. Just in time for Oktoberfest celebrations and



fall beer-cations, <u>Visit Oceanside</u> and local brewery, <u>Craft Coast</u>, launched a collaboration that captures the essence of Oceanside and its vibrant craft beer scene. Concocted by the iconic brewers at Craft Coast, "Oceanside O'riginal" is a tropical, citrusy Cali-pilsner, a perfect pair for a typical O'side day: sun, sand and a brew in-hand. The collaboration with Visit Oceanside introduces a limited-edition can design that reflects Oceanside's bright, welcoming personality, fun surf culture, and laid-back attitude featuring playful elements such as a surfing taco alongside graphics of iconic O'side landmarks, including the beloved Oceanside Pier. The cans are available at Craft Coast locations and retail spots throughout Oceanside including Mission Pacific Beach Hotel.

October is also for the oenophiles! <u>Valle</u>, Oceanside's Michelin-starred restaurant helmed by Executive Chef Roberto Alcocer, will be hosting the inaugural <u>O'Wineside event</u> on October 22nd, featuring 25+ premier Mexican wineries, gourmet bites like Baja oysters, Sterling Caviar, and Jamon Iberico, all set against the stunning backdrop of the Pacific Ocean. South Oceanside adds another eating and drinking hotspot this fall with the opening of <u>Merenda Wine</u> <u>Bar</u>. Created by Oceanside local Aaron Crossland and his wife Lauren, Merenda will bring a slice of Europe with a wine program featuring Old World classics and selections from emerging regions as well as seasonal small plates and house-made salumi.





### **All-Ages Active Outdoor Events**

On November 2nd, <u>Bike the Coast</u> returns, bringing together first-time riders, experienced groups, and every type of cyclist in between to ride routes of 7, 15, 24, 50, or 100 miles on historic Highway 101. Travel through Oceanside, Carlsbad, Encinitas,



Solana Beach, and Del Mar, beginning and ending with a celebration at the Oceanside Pier with food, craft beer, live music, expo shopping, and fun. <u>Valley</u> <u>Arts Festival</u> celebrating history and culture of Oceanside's native Luiseno people returns November 16 to Oceanside's Heritage Park. The outdoor festival for all ages includes traditional food, dance and crafts such as basket weaving, Native American flute, gourd painting, Indian fry bread and more. And O'side's "move your feet before you eat" Thanksgiving tradition continues with <u>Oceanside's 19th</u> <u>Annual Turkey Trot 5K Run/Walk & Kids Run</u>. The event offers a costume contest, the largest teams competition, fabulous live entertainment on the course, and

finisher medals for all participants. Free digital photos, medals, shirts, and live results to all registered participants. The event has raised over \$470,000 for nonprofits that serve O'side residents.
